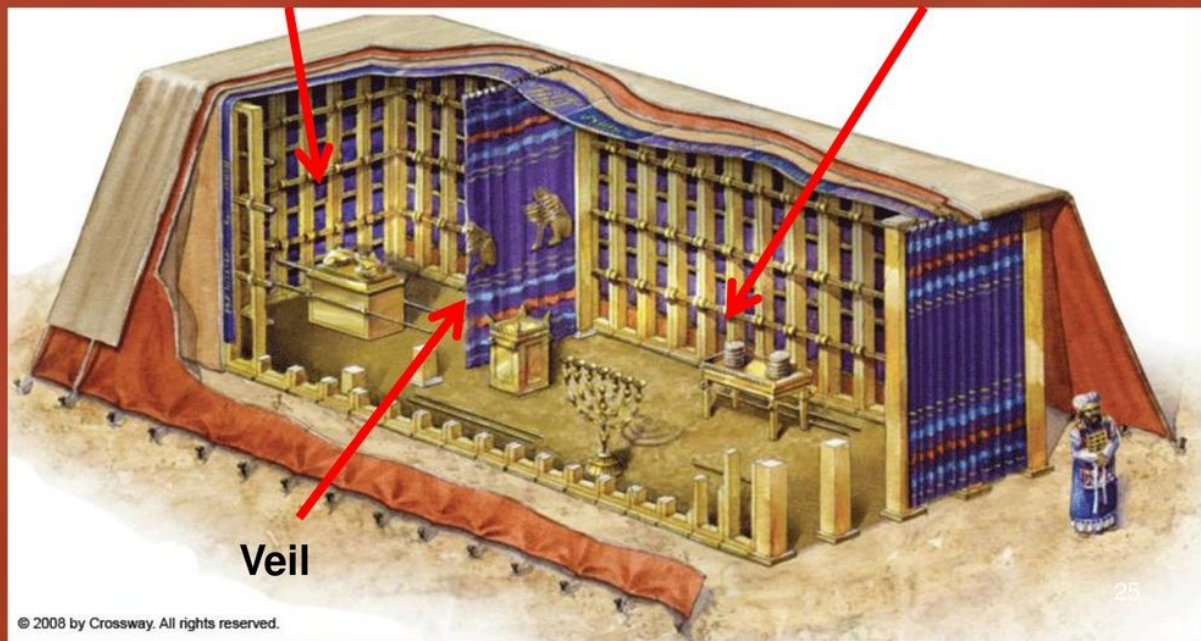

The walls of the Tabernacle were composed of 48 wooden boards, overlaid with gold, each about 15 feet high and 2½ feet wide.

Each board had two "tenons," or knobs at the base, which fit into two sockets of silver buried in the sand.

The boards rested on 96 sockets of silver. Each socket of silver weighed over 90 pounds.

Thus the Tabernacle stood upon a solid foundation of silver, weighing over four and a half tons!
